Our 2016 survey of participants suggests that:



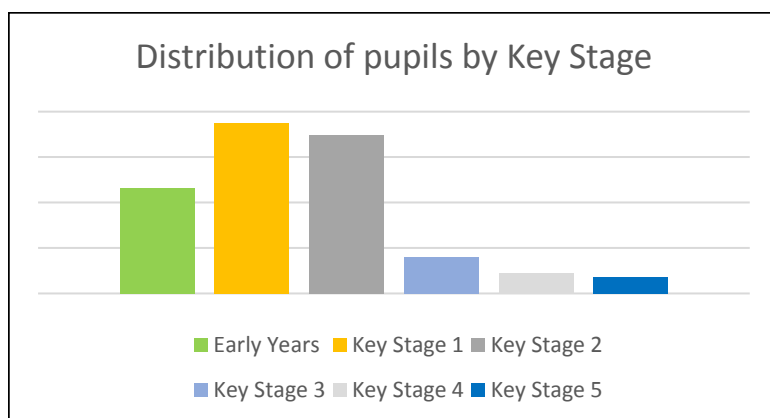
85%
