The weekend experience will be Friday 28th June - Sunday 30th June 2019

You will live, learn and enjoy life on a real working commercial farm at Coleg Cambria Llysfasi, Ruthin, North Wales. Llysfasi is a land based college with departments in Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Care and Forestry and Countryside Management. The college has 970 acres and is a working farm with dairy cows, sheep, beef cattle, crops, forestry and an animal management centre. The competition is a collaboration with LEAF Education – working to inspire future generations about farming, food and the natural environment and delivering to over 10,560 young people last year and 459 schools across England and Wales.

The weekend prize will be for the schools that best answer the questions below; the winning teams will be from 7 schools - 1 teacher and 3 students (aged 14-16) from each school.

The weekend will be made up of fun and educational activities based around the college farm. You will experience milking cows, handling lambs, tour the animal centre, feed the calves, learn about countryside management, visit the Agri-forest, have a go at tractor driving and operating a mini digger, experience modern technology used in farming and much more.

The weekend will have a range of educational topics, and you will compete in the competition over the weekend - the winning school team will be crowned the 'Innovation school of the year 2019 in food, farming and environment.'
